Designation of Aviation Medical Examiners (DAMEs)

In collaboration with Rwanda Military Hospital, Rwanda Civil Aviation Authority (RCAA) has designated **Dr. Eugene Twagirumukiza** and **Dr. Eugene Gisanura Ngabo** as aviation medical examiners (DAMEs) to conduct medical examinations of fitness of applicants for licences, certificates or ratings for which medical requirements are prescribed by Rwanda Civil Aviation (Personnel Licensing) Regulations.

Effective **15 December 2014**, all applicants for medical certificates should seek appointment from above mentioned DAMEs for medical assessment.

No medical certificate issued by any other medical examiner on or after 15 December 2014 shall be accepted by RCAA. The medical certificates issued before 15 December 2014 shall continue valid for remaining validity period. Thereafter, the medical assessment shall be conducted by the above DAMEs and a new medical certificate issued.

Application forms for aviation medical assessment (*Form MED001*) will be obtained from DAMEs. This implies that there will be no application forms for aviation medical assessment issued by RCAA licensing office. Copies of blank medical certificates are also held by the DAMEs.

For identification purposes, all applicants presenting themselves for medical assessment must bring photographic identification document such as National Identity Card or Passport. No medical assessment will be conducted for an applicant with no photographic identification document.

The DAME will be responsible for forwarding to the RCAA each medical report or ancillary report received concerning an applicant for medical certification. Under no circumstances should an applicant request for medical report from the DAME to dispatch to RCAA.

Note: When the medical certificate has been issued, the applicant is required to make a copy of the medical certificate and leave the copy with DAME to accompany the medical report when submitted to RCAA.
